*SFWAR has several opportunities for Internships for the upcoming **WALK AGAINST RAPE**. Volunteers for these positions will have the opportunity to learn about several facets of the Development Program in a community based Rape Crisis Center, and will focus on the following areas: special events, fundraising, media outreach, community mobilization and partnership, and volunteer co-ordination.*

Volunteers will work closely with the Development Director and Associate. SFWAR is located at the Women's Building in San Francisco's Mission District and is walking distance from the 16th & Mission and 24th & Mission BART. Our volunteers are a thriving force for SFWAR, and are very much appreciated for their support towards our goal of ending violence in our communities.

COMMUNITY LIAISON INTERN

This intern will:

- Outreach to community organizations and social justice networks to get the word out about Walk Against Rape 2017.
- Make presentations to schools and partner organizations when required.

MEDIA OUTREACH INTERN

This intern will liaison with media outlets, including social media, radio, and television to send out press releases about Walk Against Rape 2017. The internship responsibilities include:

- Execute social media strategy—featuring updates and event specials, promotional campaigns, and community engagement.
- Execute press outreach and assist with media monitoring.
- Identify and co-ordinate outreach at appropriate local events.
- Create event updates for the event website, and occasionally for Facebook.

IN-KIND DONATIONS INTERN

This intern will:

- Support the Development Team in solicitation of In-Kind Donations.
- Assist with scheduling and pick-up of in-kind donations.

VOLUNTEER AND/LOGISTICS INTERN

This intern will:

- Recruit new volunteers for Walk Against Rape 2017: This includes posting information about needs on pre-approved volunteer recruitment websites and creating information on volunteer opportunities for posting.
- Coordinate volunteers on the day of Walk Against Rape 2017.

SPONSORSHIP INTERN

This intern will:

- Support the Development Team with outreach using specific letters, solicitation packets, and proposals for event partnerships and sponsorships.
- Help identify potential new corporate donors and marketing partnerships.

Time Commitment:

- Most Internship commitments are a minimum of 8 hours/week for 6-12 weeks.
- Two to three days a week (set schedule will be determined based on intern availability).
- Occasional evenings, or weekends may be required.

Learning Potential:

- Experience working directly with SFWAR's development program in all aspects of special event fundraising, relationship building and logistics.
- Networking opportunities with corporate partners, community based organizations and donors.
- Access to SFWAR staff and community as well as mentorship opportunities.
- Letter of recommendation based on internship.
